

MCMILLAN COMMUNITY COUNCIL MINUTES

Agenda items

- Nate Auwerda welcomed everyone. Review of agenda. Motion to approve by Stephanie Richter. Hannah Dolata seconded the motion. Agenda was approved.
- Reviewed February meeting minutes. Linda Auwerda motioned to approve the February minutes. Samantha Walters seconded the motion. Minutes were approved.
- Proposed School Community Council Amendment to the budget from Hannah Dolata. She proposed moving money from Salaries and Employee Benefits that were not used this year to Supplies for FOSS kits. This will provide McMillan with a full science curriculum. The quote for the FOSS kits is \$15,712.37. It will include eLicences that will be held by the school and not individual teachers. They will be able to work with the Jordan School District to have access to their learning options as well. They are excited to be able to have this learning option for all the kids at McMillan. A vote was taken and we had 7 yays and 0 nays from the council. This will now be presented to the Murray School Board for approval.
- District Progress related to State Early Literacy Goals. Hannah Dolata was hoping to have the breakdown for McMillan from the state and district regarding Early Literacy Goals for K-3. The state requires a minimum of 60% on the Pathway to Progress Report for students reading growth. Murray School District had a 52% result. Hoping the numbers for McMillan are higher but until the numbers are received they have taken some proactive steps already at McMillan. Working with our Literacy counselor they have looked into individual students at McMillan and are working with teachers to implement a "Focus Friends" program. This will focus on students in the red and yellow reading zones to help create learning options for these students and teachers to work on.

- Equity Data - Attendance Focus. Hannah Dolata spoke about a presentation that was given at the Murray School District council meeting last month regarding equity and attendance focus. She was waiting on a report regarding an attendance breakdown but the report was not available prior to our meeting. They are working on ways to help students feel represented and included. We will follow up on the report next month when she receives it.
- Technology Update - Murray School District has outsourced installation of the 16 new monitors that will be put in the classrooms. They have not received official dates but are hoping to be able to have them installed after school hours or during teacher work days so they will not interfere with teaching.
- A motion was made by Hannah Dolata to adjourn the meeting and Samanth Walters seconded the motion.
